

CHILI COOK OFF APPLICATION & INFORMATION

Thank you for agreeing to bring a pot or crock pot of chili for the first TLC Women's Center's Chili Cook Off. This chili cook off is in conjunction with TLC Women's Center's Barbecue & Silent Auction. Proceeds from the Auction and the Barbecue will go to TLC Women's Center, a mission to help families in an unplanned pregnancy. Each chili entry will be judged by a committee and by those who taste/vote(see below)

Chili Cook Off Format and Important Information: Chili entries may be made by one representative from each church.. You may check with your church rep or TLC for a chance to enter. **Each entry should include a pot of chili, cheese (or appropriate topping) and a serving spoon,** Each pot of chili will be given a number so the cook/entrant will be anonymous; however, you need to provide your chili with a name that describes your chili so those eating the chili will have an idea of what to expect when they eat your chili.

Judging: There are three judging categories: *Judges' Choice*, *People's Choice* and *Best Vegetarian Chili*. Chili entries will be judged by a committee of representatives from our Board of Directors and local Businesses (5 Judges). The judges will determine the winners by sampling each chili entry. Each judge will rate the aroma, appearance, texture, taste of each chili entry and then the committee will determine the winner in the Judges' Choice category. For the People's Choice category, one voting ballot per category will be given to each guest. Everyone who chooses to cast a ballot for his/her favorite chili may do so. The winner of the People's Choice category will be determined by the chili entry with the highest number of votes. Winners of each category will be given the Silver Spoon Award. Pre-registration is required to be considered for either judging category.

Chili Cook Off Set Up: You (or your designee) **should bring the chili, cheese (or appropriate topping), to St. Paul's Prebyterian 4917 Eli St. Orlando, FL 02804 between 3:00 p.m. and 6:45 p.m. on Thursday, October 7th.** We will have tables set up, extension cords, and multi plugs.. All we need from you is your pot of chili, your serving spoon and your topping (if applicable). To keep your chili warm (or hot in many cases), you will probably want to bring it in a crock pot. We will not have any other mechanism for keeping your chili warm except extension cords and multi plugs. After the Barbeque we will ask you to pick up your crock pot and serving spoon.

Chili Name: You need to give your chili a name that describes it, so those eating the chili will have an idea of what to expect when they eat your chili. Some examples might be Western Texas Chili At Its Best; HOT Peppers Chili, Veggie & Delicious, etc.

Please complete the online application below. We must have your application no later than September 30th 2010. Entries limited to the first 20 registered; this is the number of pots we can accommodate on the electrical outlets. Once registered we will let you know if you are eligible to be the chili representative from your church.
